By Car:

Please note that when using SatNav the old postcode SK1 3QL should currently be used.

Cooper Street can only be accessed by vehicle from the Higher Hillgate end; there is only pedestrian access from the A6.

There are ten car parking spaces (plus two disabled bays) at the Meeting House. Additional parking is available on Higher Hillgate, and on Cooper Street after 6 pm weekdays and all day at weekends.

By train:

Stockport has frequent train services from Manchester Piccadilly and the south. The Meeting House is 15 – 20 minutes' walk from Stockport Station. It is five minutes' journey by taxi from the station and there are always plenty available.

If walking from the Station, exit the front of the station, turn right past the taxi rank, then left at the mini roundabout and join the A6 at Stockport Old Infirmary. Turn right along the A6, Wellington Road South, passing the Town Hall on your left and Stockport Art Gallery and Stockport College on your right. Cross the road by the College and continue past the Masonic Hall and Co-op, then turn left through the pedestrian passageway between Brookfield House and the small car park immediately before the junction of the A6 and Longshut Lane. The Meeting House is at the end of Cooper Street on the right.

If walking north on the A6 towards Stockport, turn right onto Longshut Lane after the large white multi-storey building St Christopher's House, past the bus stop on the left, and the Meeting House is prominent.

Alternatively, the 192 bus is very frequent, every few minutes, and can be caught from the stop opposite McDonalds on the A6. Exit the Station at the front, cross the small zebra crossing, up the steps directly in front, past Cineworld and onto the A6. The bus stop is on the opposite side, facing MacDonalDs. Alight after two stops outside the Masonic Hall, or three stops outside St Christopher's House.

By bus:

The 192 bus is a direct service from Manchester City Centre, and can be caught from either Piccadilly Gardens or Piccadilly Station. Very frequent service to Hazel Grove or Stepping Hill (do not board if that particular bus terminates in Stockport). The journey takes approximately 45 minutes, can be longer during busy periods.

From the south the 192 commences in Hazel Grove and the 199 from Buxton – alight outside the Swansway Honda car showroom at the junction with Longshut Lane West.

Places to eat:

The Fairway pub diagonally opposite the Meeting House on the corner of Higher Hillgate – serves lunch 12.00 – 2.00 pm, and evening meals

Harappa Indian restaurant and take away, 3 minutes' walk from the Meeting House at 106 Higher Hillgate – very good food served 4.30 – 11.00 pm

Brooklyn Pottery and Cafe – 10 minutes' walk from the Meeting House along Longshut Lane West to the junction with Shaw Heath for teas, coffee and desserts – open Wednesday to Saturday 10.00 am – 5 pm
